CONSUMER AFFAIRS ACT 1973

CONSUMER PRODUCT SAFETY ORDER

I, GARY HUMPHRIES, Minister for Fair Trading, pursuant to paragraph 15FC (1)(a) of the *Consumer Affairs Act 1973*, make a consumer product safety order prohibiting the supply of goods described as

Portable folding cots with at least one foldable top rail where

- (a) the top rail consists of two rods,
- (b) one end of each rod fits between the walls of the U-shaped mechanism ("the mechanism") so that the rod's longitudinal axis is between, and parallel to, the walls of the mechanism;
- (c) that end of the rod has a fitting which is attached to the walls of the mechanism by a pin which is transverse to the rod's longitudinal axis and to the walls of the mechanism;
- (d) each pin acts as a hinge which allows the relevant rod to turn about the longitudinal axis of the pin,
- (e) when the top rail is locked-
  - (i) the two rods form an angle approximating 180 degrees; and
  - (ii) the mechanism is turned 180 degrees about the longitudinal axis of the two rods to secure them in a locked position,

being the portable cots known as;

- “Travel D’Lite”;
- “Play D’Lite”;
- “Rest D’Lite”;
- “Travel Express”; and
- “Chicco Travel Bed”.
