

DRAFT VARIATION NO. 111 TO THE TERRITORY PLAN CANBERRA CENTRE CONSOLIDATION AINSLIE AVENUE, CIVIC

A draft Variation to the Territory Plan, concerning the proposed Canberra Centre Consolidation, has been prepared by the Planning and Land Management Group (PALM) of the Department of Urban Services (incorporating the functions of the ACT Planning Authority)

Draft Variation No.111 to the Territory Plan has been released as a joint document with draft Amendment No.23 to the National Capital Plan.

Draft Variation No 111 to the Territory Plan proposes to

- vary the land use policy on the Territory Plan Map for that part of Ainslie Avenue identified in Figure B1 of Attachment B from 'Designated Area' to 'Civic Centre (Commercial A)' and 'Major Road',
- remove the overlay symbol on the Territory Plan Map indicating that special requirements apply in the National Capital Plan flanking Main Avenues and Approach Routes,
- amend Figure 1 of the Civic Centre policy in Part B2A of the Territory Plan Written Statement to include part of Ainslie Avenue from Bunda Street to the west side of Ballumbir Street in the Precinct 'd' Car parking area and to adjust the boundary of the Precinct 'a1' Retail core area; and
- add controls for development over Ainslie Avenue to the controls for the Car parking precinct at Clause 4 8 of the Civic Centre policy in Part B2A of the Territory Plan Written Statement.

This draft Variation, provided it is not deferred, has interim effect until 9 July 1999, or for the "defined period", whichever is the shorter. The "defined period" commences on Friday 10 July 1998 and continues until the draft Variation, or the corresponding Plan Variation.

is rejected by the Legislative Assembly, or

is withdrawn

While the draft Variation has interim effect the Territory, the Executive, a Minister or a Territory Authority shall not do, or approve, any act which would be inconsistent with the Territory Plan, or the Plan if it was varied in accordance with this draft Variation

Section 11 of the Land (Planning and Environment) Act 1991 (the Land Act), concerning the Heritage Places Register, does not apply to this draft Variation


