The Nurses Board of the ACT (the Board) held an Inquiry into the conduct of Ms Anna Maria Forster, Registered Nurse, under section 66 of the *Nurses Act 1988* (the Act).

The Board on 7 August 1998 reprimanded Anna Maria Forster, under paragraph 64(1)(a) of the Act and imposed the following condition on her registration under paragraph 64(1)(c) of the Act: that

'Anna Maria Foster not provide nursing to persons under 16 years of age until such time as she has successfully completed a graduate certificate course in paediatric nursing or a post graduate diploma in paediatric nursing'.

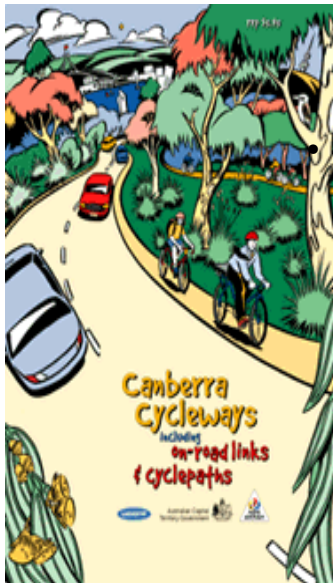
