As required by Subsection 15(6)(b) of the *Independent Pricing And Regulatory Commission Act 1997*, I hereby give notice of the reasons for amending the original terms of reference for the ACTEW Corporation Medium Term Price Path Inquiry Gazetted on 28 November 1997.
