### DRAFT VARIATION NO.102 TO THE TERRITORY PLAN HERITAGE PLACES REGISTER

#### DRAFT VARIATION NO.123 TO THE TERRITORY PLAN GRIFFITH SECTION 39 BLOCK 18 (PART)

Two draft Variations to the Territory Plan have been prepared by the Planning and Land Management Group (PALM) of the Urban Services Department (incorporating the functions of the ACT Planning Authority). These relate to the Heritage Places Register and to a block of land in Griffith at Section 39 Block 18 (part).

**Draft Variation No.102, Heritage Places Register,** proposes to enter four additional places onto the Heritage Places Register as part of the Territory Plan. These are:

- Kingston/Griffith Housing Precinct;
- Blandfordia 5 Precinct, Griffith/Forrest/Red Hill;
- Wakefield Gardens Precinct, Ainslie; and
- · Evans Crescent Housing, Griffith.

The areas covered by the draft Variation are shown on the maps below.



Fig 1 Kingston/Griffith Housing Precinct




Fig 2 Blandfordia 5 Precinct, Griffith/Forrest/Red Hill




Fig 3 Wakefield Gardens Precinct, Ainslie





Fig 4 Evans Crescent Housing, Griffith

Under the provision of section 11 of the Land (Planning and Environment) Act 1991 (the Land Act) this draft Variation (No.102) has no interim effect as prescribed by section 9 of the Land Act.

**Draft Variation No.123, for Griffith Section 39 Block 18 (part),** proposes to change the Land Use Policy from Urban Open Space to Residential and also to remove the Public Land Overlay from the changed Land Use Policy Area.

The area covered by the draft Variation is shown on the map below.



Provided it is not deferred, the provisions of this draft Variation (No.123) have interim effect until 27 October 1999 or for the "defined period", whichever is the shorter. The "defined period" commenced on 28 October 1998 and continues until the proposals in the draft Variation, or the corresponding Plan Variation:

- · come into effect;
- or are rejected by the Legislative Assembly;
- or are withdrawn.

During the period these provisions have interim effect, the Territory, the Executive, a Minister or a Territory Authority shall not do, or approve the doing of, any act which would be inconsistent with the Territory Plan, or the Plan if it was varied in accordance with the provisions of the draft Variation.

Section 11 of the Land (Planning and Environment) Act 1991 (the Land Act), concerning the Heritage Places Register, does not apply to draft Variation No.123.
