



EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR A SPATIAL DATA MANAGEMENT SYSTEM EOI No T980027

The ACT Land Information Centre (ACTLIC), the ACT Government's lead land information and mapping agency, is seeking Expressions of Interest (EOI) for the acquisition of a Spatial Data Management System (SDMS). ACTLIC is a business unit in the Department of Urban Services' Planning and Land Management Group (PALM).

ACTLIC is custodian of the ACT's primary Land Information System, ACTMAP. The new SDMS will replace the existing ACTMAP system and will provide the necessary tools to support PALM user requirements for spatial applications. In addition, the SDMS will improve the accessibility of ACTLIC's spatial data for both PALM and other users.

The acquisition process involves an EOI followed by a restricted Request for Proposal (RFP). Suppliers wishing to be considered for the RFP must reply to the EOI.

Key components of this acquisition are

- The translation of spatial data from the existing proprietary system to an Oracle RDBMS,
- Spatial data modelling,
- Interface development,
- System software installation, and
- User training.
