ACT GOVERNMENT PLANNING AND LAND MANAGEMENT GROUP

DRAFT VARIATION NO 89 TO THE TERRITORY PLAN FOR MURRUMBIDGEE AND LOWER MOLONGLO RIVERS AND DRAFT VARIATION NO. 93 TO THE TERRITORY PLAN FOR NARRABUNDAH SECTION 34 BLOCK 16 AND PART BLOCK 27 - B5 RESTRICTED ACCESS RECREATION LAND USE POLICIES (GOLF FACILITY)

The Planning and Land Management Group (PALM) of the Department of Urban Services (incorporating the ACT Planning Authority) is proposing two draft Variations to the Territory Plan which, if adopted, would

- for draft Variation No.89, refine the Public Land Overlays and 13 B Area Specific Policy in the Murrumbidgee and Lower Molonglo River Corridors, and
- for draft Variation No.93, permit a golf facility at Narrabundah on the corner of Jerrabomberra Avenue and Hindmarsh Drive. The Land Use Policy would be varied from Urban Open Space to Restricted Access Recreation.

These draft Variations are to have interim effect under the provision of section 9 of the *Land (Planning and Environment) Act 1991* for the "defined period"
