EFFECT OF INCLUSION IN AN INTERIM REGISTER

Pursuant to section 55 of the Land (Planning and Environment) Act 1991, during the defined period an interim Heritage Places Register has effect as if it were the Heritage Places Register

The Interim Heritage Places Register is in the form of an interim variation to the Heritage Places Register. During the defined period the Territory, the Executive, a Minister, or a Territory authority shall not do any act, or approve the doing of any act, which would be inconsistent with the Heritage Places Register if it were varied in accordance with the interim variation.

The defined period' referred to above means the period commencing on the date of publication of this notice and terminating on the expiration of the day before the date a variation to the Heritage Places Register prepared in consideration of this interim Register comes into effect under section 30, or

- the intemm Hentage Places Register is revised by the Council under s 62,
- the corresponding draft Plan variation is withdrawn by the ACT Planning Authority,
- the Executive revokes its approval of the corresponding Plan variation,
- the corresponding Plan variation is withdrawn by the ACT Assembly, or withdrawn by the Minister under s 29

REVIEW OF DECISION

Pursuant to section 282A(5)) of the Land (Planning and Environment) Act 1991, a person whose interests are substantially and adversely affected by the decision may apply to the Administrative Appeals Tribunal (AAT) for a review of the above decision of the Hentage Council to include a provision, in respect of a place listed above, in an interim Hentage Place Register

If you believe that your interests are substantially and adversely affected by the inclusion of any of the above places in an interim Heritage Places Register, you should notify the Secretary, ACT Heritage Council at the address given below and you will be provided with a notice of the Council's decision set out in accordance with the requirements of the code of practice in force under a 25B(1) of the AAT Act 1989
