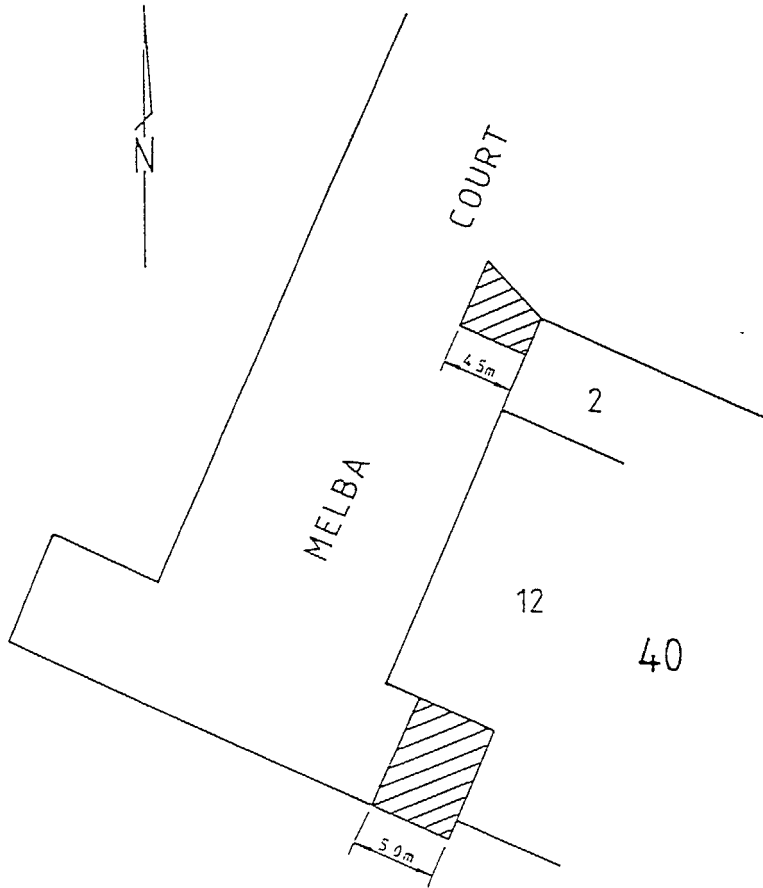



Parts of the road known as Melba Court adjacent to Section 40 in the Division of Melba in the District of Belconnen, shown hatched on the plan annexed hereto


