### NOTICE OF APPROVAL OF BREATH ANALYSING INSTRUMENT

In pursuance of sub-section 5(1) of the *Road Transport (Alcohol and Drugs) Act 1977* (*the Act*) I being of opinion :-

- (a) that the Drager Alcotest 7110 Breath Analysing Instrument is a particular type of instrument, designed and constructed to ascertain the concentration of alcohol present in a sample of a person's breath and is capable of recording that concentration in grams per 100 millilitres of blood; and
- (b) is suitable for use in analyses under Part II,

HEREBY APPROVE that type of instrument for the purposes of the Act.

### NOTICE OF APPROVAL OF SCREENING DEVICE

In pursuance of sub-section 5(2) of the Road Transport (Alcohol and Drugs) Act 1977 (the Act) I being of opinion:

- (a) that the lion alcolmeter® SD-400 is a device of that type of devices that have been designed and made for the purpose of indicating, when a sample of the breath of a person is exhaled into the device, whether alcohol is present in the blood of the person and, if so, of giving an indication of the concentration of alcohol in the blood of the person; and
- (c) the lion alcolmeter® SD-400 is a device of that type of devices that are suitable for use in tests under Part II.

HEREBY APPROVE that type of screening device for the purposes of the Act.

### **DECLARATION No. 1 OF 2000**

### DECLARATION OF AREAS TO BE DEFINED AS ROAD RELATED AREAS

Under section 12(1)(a) of the *Road Transport (General) Act 1999* (the Act) I declare that the road transport legislation applies to the following areas that are open to or used by the public:

- (a) a wharf, pier or jetty;
- (b) the lake foreshores (within the meaning of the Lakes Act 1976) of any lake;
- (c) any part of a park, reserve, recreational or sporting ground, racecourse, or any other open place, to which the public has access whether with or without payment for admission.
