Information for the applicant

Who is entitled to apply for a postal vote, or to vote in person at a pre-poll voting centre?

You are entitled to apply for a postal vote, or to vote in person at a pre-poll voting centre, if you:

- are on the ACT electoral roll; and
- expect to be unable to attend a polling place on polling day.

To apply for a postal vote, complete this application and mail or fax it to receive voting material by post

If you wish to vote by post, complete and return this application. Postal voting material will be posted to you at home or your designated postal address.

You can post your application to the ACT Electoral Commission, PO Box 272, Civic Square ACT 2608 or fax it to (02) 6205 0382.

Your application must be received by the ACT Electoral Commission by no later than 5:00 pm on the Thursday before polling day.

Alternatively, you may vote in person at a pre-poll voting centre

A written application is not required if you prefer to vote in person at any of the advertised pre-poll voting centres.

The location and opening times of pre-poll voting centres will be available from the Commission's website at www.elections.act.gov.au.

They will also be published in local newspapers in the period leading up to polling day or phone (02) 6205 0033 for details.

Information for the witness

Who can be a witness?

If you are in Australia, this application must be witnessed by an elector whose name appears on a Commonwealth of Australia electoral roll. If you are overseas, any person 18 years of age or older may be a witness.

A candidate for election cannot be a witness.

Duties of a witness

As a witness you must:

- be satisfied as to the identity of the applicant;
- see the applicant sign the application;
- be satisfied that the statements contained in the application are true; and
- sign the application, add the date and your name and address.
