Remand Centres Act 1976

**DECLARATION OF TEMPORARY REMAND
CENTRE**

Pursuant to section 5 (1) of the *Remand Centres Act 1976* ('the Act'), the Administrator appointed pursuant to section 6 (1) of the *Remand Centres Act 1976* has informed me that:

- (a) the number of detainees in the remand centre declared by instrument under section 4 of the *Remand Centres Act* and published in the *Commonwealth of Australia Gazette* No S 169 of 27 September 1976 ('the Centre') is likely to be greater than the number that can be held conveniently in the centre; and
- (b) it is not convenient to transfer some detainees to another institution, within or outside the Territory.

Therefore, under section 5 (5) of the Act I, MAURICE REA SEXTON, extend for twelve months the Declaration of a Temporary Remand Centre published in the *Commonwealth of Australia Gazette* No. S 276 of 15 September 1988 relating to the area of land on which is located that portion of the Belconnen Police Station known as Cells 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 and the washroom and exercise yard (male) as applicable and Cells 7 and 8 and the washroom and exercise yard (female) as applicable being part of Section 23 Belconnen
