## REMAND CENTRES ACT 1976

## DECLARATION OF TEMPORARY REMAND CENTRE

Pursuant to Section 5(1) of the Remand Centres Act 1976 ("the Act") the Administrator appointed pursuant to Section 6(1) of the Remand Centres Act 1976 has informed me that:

- (a) the number of detainees in the remand centre declared by instrument under Section 4 of the Remand Centres Act and published in the Commonwealth of Australia Gazette No. S169 of 27 September 1976 is likely to be greater than the number that can be held conveniently in the centre; and
- (b) it is not convenient of transfer some detainees to another institution, within or outside the Territory.

Therefore, under Section 5(5) of the Act I, PETER CHIVERS, extend for 12 months the Declaration of a Temporary Remand Centre published in the Australian Capital Territory Gazette No. S25 of 18 September 1989 relating to the area of land on which is located that portion of the Belconnen Police Station known as Cells 1,2.3,4,5 and 6 and the washroom and exercise yard (male) as applicable and Cells 7 and 3 and the washroom and exercise yard (female) as applicable being part of Section 23 Belconnen.
