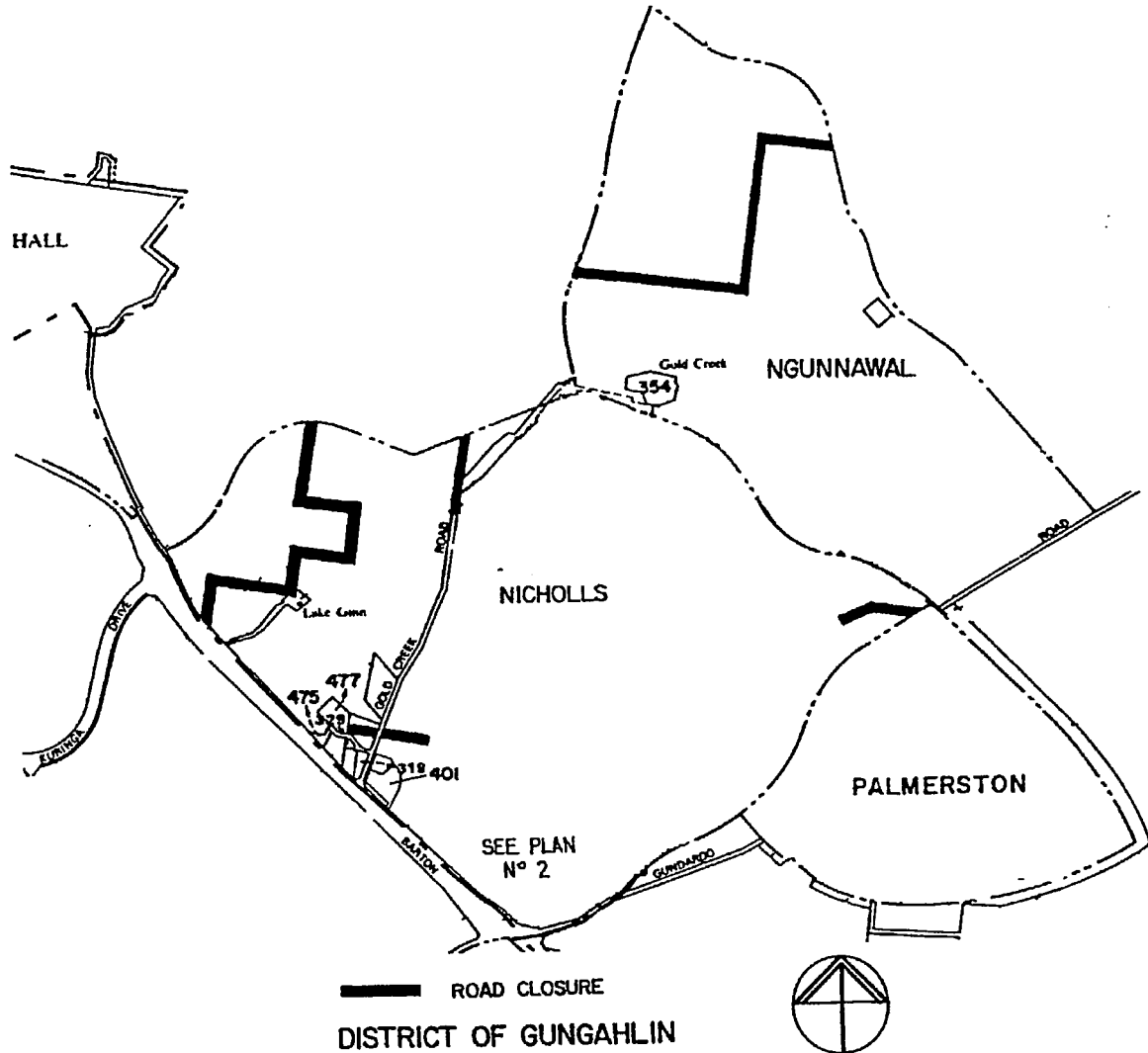

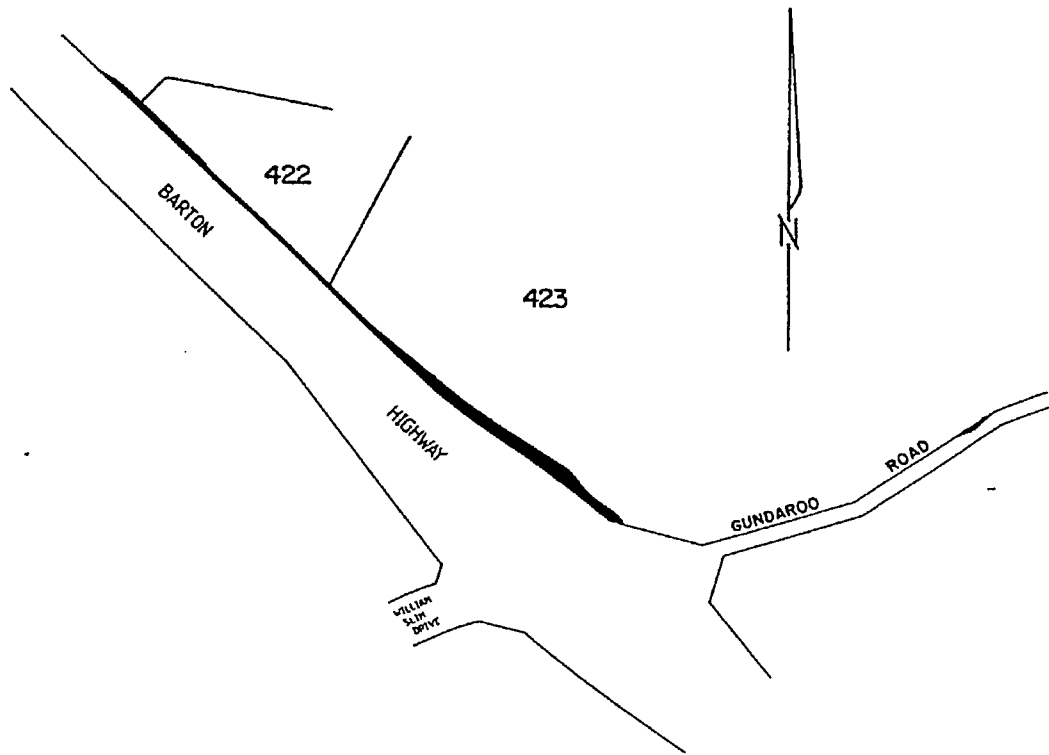
Plan No. 1: Old New South Wales crown road reserves within the Divisions of Nicholls and Ngunnawal in the District of Gungahlin.
