KINGSTON SECTION 25 BLOCKS 4-6 AND THE GUIDELINES FOR REDEVELOPMENT OF KINGSTON/GRIFFITH

The ACT Planning Authority is inviting comment on a draft Variation to the Territory Plan for Kingston Section 25 Blocks 4-6 and changes to the Guidelines for Redevelopment of Kingston/Griffith.

The proposed development of Kingston Section 25 Blocks 4-6 includes:

- . 85 residential units
- . 1330m² commercial space
- . 86 publicly available parking spaces, and
- . 154 car parking spaces for the residential and commercial development.

The buildings are proposed to be 3 and 4 storeys in height with some basements.

The variation to the Guidelines for Redevelopment of Kingston/Griffith will remove the possibility of further tower blocks in the area.
