



CONSUMER AFFAIRS ACT 1973

CONSUMER PRODUCT SAFETY ORDER

I, Terence Connolly, being satisfied that an order is reasonable and necessary to prevent or reduce the risk of injury to, or impairment of health of, any person arising out of the possession, handling or use of those goods by that person or any other person, order that supply of 'imitation confectionary made of glass' be prohibited in the Australian Capital Territory under Section 15 FC (1) of the *Consumer Affairs Act 1973*, as the goods do not comply with the requirements of the 'Ingestion or Inhalation Hazard Test' in Appendix D of Australian Standard AS 1647.2 (Children's Toys).
