APPROVAL OF OFFICIAL MARK ON BALLOT PAPERS

Pursuant to subsection 114(3) of the *Electoral Act 1992*, I hereby APPROVE the official mark to be borne on ballot papers for the Legislative Assembly election and referendum on 18 February 1995, a sample of which is held on file number 95/05337 at the Office of the ACT Electoral Commission, described as follows:

The Background Security Pattern used on the ballot paper is composed of frequency modulated sine wave lines step and repeated (non-uniformly, so as to create a pattern). The pattern is superimposed over a dot screen which incorporates a hidden word, 'COPY'.
