## Direction to Notify an Interim Heritage Place Register for Aboriginal Places

Notifiable Instrument NI 2002 — 19

made under the

Land (Planning and Environment) Act 1991, Section no 60 (1)

Pursuant to section 60(1) of the *Land (Planning and Environment) Act 1991* (the Act) notice is given that the Minister has made a decision under section 69 (1) (a) to direct the Heritage Council to notify an interim Heritage Places register for the following places:

- Aboriginal Places (5), Districts of Majura and Kowen, ACT
- Aboriginal Place (250), Districts of Belconnen and Majura, ACT

Copies of the interim Register entries may be viewed at the Environment Information Centre, Level 2, Macarthur House, 12 Wattle Street, Lyneham and at ACT Government Shopfronts and Public Libraries, during office hours.

For the purpose of section 55 of the Act., the maximum period this interim Heritage Places register will have effect is **3 years** from the date this notice is notified on the ACT Legislation Register.

## EFFECT OF INCLUSION IN AN INTERIM REGISTER

Under section 55(2) of the Act, during the defined period the Territory, the Executive, a Minister, or a Territory authority shall not do any act, or approve the doing of any act, which –

- (a) would be inconsistent with the heritage places register if it were varied in accordance with the interim variation; or
- (b) is inconsistent with the heritage places register.

The 'defined period' means the period beginning on the day the interim Register is notified (other than in a newspaper) as required by section 60 of the Act and ending at the end of the earlier of:-

- (a) the day before the heritage register prepared in consideration of the interim register commences under section 29 (6) or section 30A (5) of the Act; or
- (b) 3 years from the date this notice is notified on the ACT Legislation Register.

## REVIEW OF DECISION

Subject to the *Administrative Appeals Tribunal Act 1989*, a person whose interests in relation to land are affected by the above decision may apply to the Administrative Appeals Tribunal (AAT) for a review of the decision of the Minister to include these places in the interim Heritage Places register.
