

Land (Planning and Environment) Bushfire Emergency (Applicable Land) Declaration (No 2) 2003

Notifiable instrument NI2003—114

made under the

Land (Planning and Environment) (Bushfire Emergency) Regulations 2003, r 7 (Fire-caused clearing developments exempted from Act, div 6.2)

- 1 I revoke declaration NI2003-62 notified on 8 February 2003 and I declare that the land mentioned in the Schedule to this instrument is land to which the Land (Planning and Environment) (Bushfire Emergency) Regulations 2003 apply.
- 2 In the Schedule:
 - a the first column is the name of a district if the second column is blank and otherwise the name of a division; and
 - b the fourth column describes in the following classes the damage to a building or structure on the land identified by the first to third columns by fire, or in the course of fighting fire, at the beginning of the bushfire emergency of January 18 to January 28 2003:
 - A – A dwelling or other primary building was destroyed or severely damaged and was uninhabitable, whether or not an outbuilding was damaged or destroyed.
 - B - A dwelling or other primary building was damaged but was habitable, whether or not an outbuilding was damaged or destroyed.
 - C - An outbuilding was destroyed or damaged, but the dwelling or other primary building was intact.
