1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the Nature Conservation (Draft Action Plan) Notice 2004 (No 1).

2 Details of instrument

The Draft ACT Lowland Native Grassland Conservation Strategy (Draft Action Plan No. 28) has been prepared. Once finalised, Action Plan No. 28 will supersede Action Plans previously published for the following declared threatened items:

- Natural Temperate Grassland
- Striped Legless Lizard *Delma impar*
- Grassland Earless Dragon *Tympanocryptis pinguicolla*
- Golden Sun Moth *Synemon plana*
- Perunga Grasshopper *Perunga ochracea*
- Button Wrinklewort *Rutidosis leptorrhynchoides*
- Ginninderra Peppercress *Lepidium ginninderrense*
