Draft variation No.214 to the Territory Plan has been prepared by the ACT Planning and Land Authority in accordance with section19 of the *Land (Planning and Environment) Act 1991* (the Act).

The draft plan variation proposes to implement the recommendations from the Master Plan for the Village of Hall as follows:

- change the land use policy for part of Kinlyside Valley from Residential to Hills Ridges and Buffer Areas Policy, to define the rural buffers to the village;
- change the land use policy for a small part of Block 4 Section 9 from Residential to Hills Ridges and Buffer Areas to allow access to the adjacent rural block;
- include the showground and the Hall Village Reserve and Halls Creek reserve in Urban Open Space and deleting the 12B Area Specific Policy Overlay, to consolidate land management;
- expand the boundary of the Hall cemetery to cater for new burials once the capacity of the existing cemetery has been utilised.

Copies of written comments received, and any response from the National Capital Authority, will be made available for public inspection at the ACT Planning and Land Authority Customer Service Centre, 16 Challis Street, Dickson, during normal office hours for a period of 15 business days after the closing date for comments.

Section 9 of the Act applies to the draft variation, which has interim effect for a maximum period of 1 year commencing on 2 December 2004 and ending on 1 December 2005. During this period, or a period commencing on

- 2 December 2004 and terminating at the expiration of the day before:
- the date the draft variation comes into effect;
- the date the corresponding plan variation is rejected by the Legislative Assembly; or
- the date the draft variation, or the corresponding plan variation, is withdrawn under section 22(1)(c), section 27(a) or section 30A(3)(b) of the Act;

whichever is shorter, the Territory, the Executive, the Minister or a Territory Authority shall not do any act, or approve the doing of any act that –

- (a) would be inconsistent with the Territory Plan, if it were varied in accordance with the draft variation; or
- (b) is inconsistent with the Territory Plan.

Section 11 of the Act does not apply because the draft variation does not vary the heritage places register.
