1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the Health (Quality Assurance Committees for The Canberra Hospital) Declaration 2005.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after it is notified.

3 Declaration

The committees named in Schedule A are established as approved public sector quality assurance committees for The Canberra Hospital.

4 Functions of the Committees

The committees named in Schedule A have the following functions:

- (a) to conduct quality assurance activities among health service providers for the purpose of assessing and evaluating the health services provided by the Territory, to report, and make recommendations, to the chief executive in relation to those services and to monitor the implementation of those recommendations; and
- (b) to conduct research or investigations into morbidity and mortality in the ACT and to report, and make recommendations, to the chief executive in relation to that research or those investigations.
