1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the Health (Clinical Audit Committee) (Approved Public Sector Quality Assurance Committee) Declaration 2005.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after it is notified.

3 Declaration

The ACT Health Clinical Audit Committee is established as and approved public sector quality assurance committee.

4 Functions of the Committee

The committee has the following functions:

- (a) to conduct quality assurance activities among health service providers for the purpose of assessing and evaluating the health services provided by the Territory, to report, and make recommendations, to the chief executive in relation to those services and to monitor the implementation of those recommendations; and

- (b) to conduct research or investigations into morbidity and mortality in the ACT and to report, and make recommendations, to the chief executive in relation to that research or those investigations.
