1 Prescribed occupation

- (1) Under the *Building Regulation 2004*, section 7A (2) (a) I declare each of the following occupations to be a *prescribed occupation*
 - (a) an occupation listed in the schedule, in so far as the occupation relates to providing adjustment, addition, alteration, construction, demolition, enhancement, maintenance, removal, renovation, repair, or upgrading services in respect of any part of a building's structure, fabric, integral fixtures, mechanical services, electrical services or piped services; or
 - (b) an occupation at the level of apprentice, assistant, associate, cadet, co-worker, instructor, labourer, leader, manager, superintendent, supervisor, trainee, trainer, or understudy in an occupation under paragraph (a); or
 - (c) an occupation however described that involves doing or assisting with the *primary tasks* of any of the occupations under paragraph (a) or (b), on a permanent, temporary or incidental basis.

(2) In this section:

primary tasks means the tasks listed as 'primary tasks' of the relevant occupations in the *Australian Standard Classification of Occupations*, second edition, ("ASCO") published by the Australian Bureau of Statistics, and available at www.abs.gov.au.

2 Relevant asbestos qualification

- (1) Under the *Building Regulation 2004*, section 7A (2) (b) I declare the qualification gained from successful completion of any 1 of the following courses, to be a *relevant asbestos qualification*
 - (a) the Course in Identification and Safe Handling of Asbestos with national accreditation number '80803ACT'; or
 - (b) the *Course in Asbestos Removal and Supervision* with the national accreditation number '80804ACT'.
- (2) A course fails to comply with this section if it is not—
 - (a) listed as an accredited course on the National Training Information Service's National register of information on courses at www.ntis.gov.au; and
 - (b) delivered by an organisation, registered as a training organisation (*RTO*) by an Australian State, Territory or Commonwealth Government, when the RTO was authorised by such a Government to deliver the course.
