1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Utilities (Revocation of Licence) Notice 2007 (No 1)*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after notification on the legislation register.

3 Revocation of utility licence—Energy One Limited

The Independent Competition and Regulatory Commission (Commission) revokes the utility licence held by Energy One Limited (Energy One) to supply electricity in the ACT. The decision to revoke Energy One's utility licence is a consequence of its suspension from the National Electricity Market.

The revocation takes immediate effect.
