Purpose

To outline the principles surrounding police interviews of prisoners in correctional centres.

Authority

Legislation

Corrections Management Act 2007, sections 14 and 15

Policy

1 Principles

- 1.1 Prisoners are entitled to legal representation when being interviewed by police.
 - 1.1.1 When a request is received by the Police (ACT Policing or another state or territory policing organisation) to interview a prisoner in ACTCS' custody the Duty Chief will ensure that the prisoner understands their right to legal representation.
 - 1.1.1.1 The prisoner will be permitted to telephone their legal representative to facilitate this.
 - 1.1.2 Prisoners may decline to have a legal representative present during the interview.
 - 1.1.2.1 Where a prisoner declines to be legally represented, the Duty Chief will ensure that the prisoner signs the Legal Representative at Police Interviews Form.

2 Custody

2.1 Prisoners who are in ACTCS custody at the time of a police interview remain in the custody of ACTCS.

CONTROLLED DOCUMENT

- 2.1.1 A Corrections Officer will be present at all times while the interview is being conducted to maintain the custody of the prisoner.
- 2.2 Where a prisoner is to be interviewed at a place outside a correctional centre (for example, at a police station), Corrections Officers will conduct the escort in accordance with the *Prisoner Escorts Policy* and *Procedure*.
