1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the Roads and Public Places (Roads and Public Places Officers – Environment Protection and Heritage) Appointment 2008 (No 1)

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after its notification day.

3 Appointment of roads and public places officers

I appoint the people who from time to time occupy the public service positions listed in column 2 of the Schedule as roads and public places officers.

Note 1 The *Legislation Act 2001* defines ‘occupy’, in relation to a position, to include hold the position, act in the position or exercise functions of the position.

Note 2 Section 2C of the *Roads and Public Places Act 1937* requires roads and public places officers to be public servants. The *Legislation Act 2001* defines ‘public servant’ to mean a person employed in the Australian Capital Territory Public Service.
