1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Sale of Motor Vehicles (Exemption of Vehicles) Declaration 2008 (No 1)*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences the day after notification.

3 Declaration

I declare the classes of vehicle listed in the Schedule to this instrument not to be motor vehicles for the purposes of the *Sale of Motor Vehicles Act 1977*.

Schedule

Sale of Motor Vehicles (Exemption of Vehicles) Declaration 2008 (No 1)

1. Mobility Scooters

Explanatory Note:

A mobility scooter, for the purposes of this instrument is defined as being designed, and while on a road or road related area is used only, to carry a person with a disability that substantially impairs the person's mobility and cannot travel faster than 10km/h on level ground.

2. Golf Buggies

Explanatory Note:

A golf buggy for the purposes of this instrument is defined as a motorised buggy or cart designed and used to carry a golfer, spectator or golfing equipment on a golf course.

3. Ride-on Mowers

Explanatory Note:

A ride-on mower for the purposes of this instrument is defined as a motor vehicle weighing not more than 250kg when unladen that is built or used only for cutting grass or for purposes incidental to cutting grass.

4. Mini-motorbikes/cars/scooters

Explanatory Note:

A mini-motorbike/car/scooter for the purposes of this instrument is defined as a vehicle designed to be used by children, with a maximum speed limit of 8km/h that cannot be easily modified to exceed this speed.
