Burgmann Anglican School – Independent preschool – Valley Campus operated by Burgmann Anglican School is exempt from complying with *Children and Young People (ACT Childcare Services) Standards 2009 (No 1)*

Independent preschools:

a) For 1-25 children there must be a minimum of one qualified and one unqualified staff member
