# Public Sector Management Standards Appointment Amendment Declaration 2009\*

#### Notifiable instrument NI2009-30

made under the

Public Sector Management Standards 2006, s 478E (Appointment by Commissioner)

### 1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Public Sector Management Standards Appointment Amendment Declaration 2009*.

## 2 Purpose

This instrument amends Notifiable instrument NI2008-491 *Public Sector Management Standards Appointment Declaration 2008 (No.1)* notified on 20 October 2008, which appointed Ian Hamill as an unattached officer to ACT Department of Treasury.

*Explanatory Note*: The *Legislation Act 2001*, s 46 provides that the power to make an instrument includes the power to amend or repeal the instrument.

## 3 Conditions of Appointment

- (a) Ian Hamill's classification on appointment will be Senior Officer Grade C.
- (b) Ian Hamill's salary on appointment to the Department of Treasury will be the base salary which he received from Rhodium Asset Solutions Pty Ltd on the day before this instrument takes effect, namely \$81,170.
- (c) Subject to part 4.3 and section 478F(2) of the *Public Sector Management Standards* 2006, on 20 October 2009 Ian Hamill will be entitled to be paid the next highest salary point within the Senior Officer Grade C classification.
- (d) To remove any doubt, these conditions of appointment replace those notified in instrument NI2008-491.

## 4 Commencement

This instrument is taken to have commenced on 21 October 2008, that is, it commences retrospectively on the same date that the instrument being amended commenced.

Explanatory Note: The Legislation Act 2001, Chapter 8 covers the commencement of laws. Section 76 provides that a Statutory Instrument may commence retrospectively so long as it does not operate to the disadvantage of a person, that is, provided it does not contain a prejudicial provision. The amending section does not operate to anyone's detriment and is therefore a non-prejudicial provision in accordance with s76 of the Legislation Act 2001.
