Jenny Wren Out of School Hours Care is exempt from complying with *Children and Young People (ACT Childcare Services) Standards 2009 (No 1)*

– Standard 3.4) *The position of the service or camp director / coordinator must be filled by an adult who has attained the age of 21 years, and who holds one of the qualifications listed e in School Age Care Specific Standard 3.3.*

Jenny Wren Out of School Hours Care is exempt from Standard 3.4. Staff over 21 years of age will support the program on a daily basis.
