6 Temporary Standard Exemption Standard

O'Connor Co-Operative School Long Day Care operated by The Young Women's Christian Association of Canberra Ltd is exempt from complying with *Children and Young People (ACT Childcare Services) Standards 2009* (*No 1*) –

Standard 1.40: At least two staff, one of whom must be qualified and nominated to be in charge, are to be present at all times when children are on the premises.

7 Explanation and Additional Conditions

The service is permitted to employ one qualified staff member only, at the before school care program on days when the number of enrolments are under seven. An emergency action plan outlining specific procedures and school staff present and available for assistance in cases of emergencies is in place.
