This instrument is to issue a *Temporary Standards Exemption* as specified in Section 749 (2) of the *Children and Young People Act 2008*.

# 6 Temporary Standard Exemption Standard

Bunyarra Children's Centre operated by The Uniting Church in Australia (Australian Capital Territory) Property Trust is exempt from complying with *Children and Young People (ACT Childcare Services) Standards 2009 (No 1)* – Standard 2.37

There must be for every fifteen (or part thereof) children: a) at least one junior toilet, or an adult toilet with a firm, stable step and junior seat; and

b) at least one hand basin with temperature controlled warm water, a firm stable step or that is at a height that enables reasonable child access.

## 7 Explanation and Additional Conditions

The service will ensure that appropriate hygiene practices are in place to ensure the safety and wellbeing of the children during a major refurbishment of the bathroom area.
