1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the Emergencies (Service Provider) Approval 2010 (No 3).

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after it is notified.

3 Approval

I approve EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AND RESCUE SERVICES to provide ambulance services in the ACT at events approved in writing by the Emergency Services Commissioner.

4 Conditions on Approval

The conditions in Schedule 1 apply to the approval.

5 Expiry

This instrument expires on 10 May 2011.

SCHEDULE 1

Conditions on EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AND RESCUE SERVICES approval under section 62(4) of the *Emergencies Act 2004*

1. The Emergency Services Commissioner's approval referred to in clause 3 of this instrument must specify the geographical boundaries of the event.
2. Emergency Management and Rescue Services must not transport any person outside the geographical boundaries of the event.
3. This instrument approves only the staff nominated in Emergency Management and Rescue Services application for approval under section 62 of the *Emergencies Act 2004*.
4. Staff not nominated in Emergency Management and Rescue Services application for approval under section 62 of the *Emergencies Act 2004* must be approved in writing by the Emergency Services Commissioner.
5. Emergency Management and Rescue Services must provide the Emergency Services Commissioner with renewed copies of any updated or renewed insurance documentation if insurance is renewed during the approval period.
6. Emergency Management and Rescue Services must provide the Emergency Services Commissioner with clinical or pharmaceutical management guidelines made by Emergency Management and Rescue Services during the approval period.
