6 Temporary Standard Exemption Standard

O'Connor Co-Operative School Long Day Care operated by The Young Women's Christian Association of Canberra Ltd is exempt from complying with *Children and Young People (ACT Childcare Services) Standards 2009* (*No 1*) –

Standard 1.47 states:

Positions requiring a qualified person must be filled by an adult who holds one of the following qualifications:

a) a Diploma in Community Services (Children's Services) or equivalent;

b) a Bachelor of Early Childhood education;

c) a recognised overseas equivalent of any of the above qualifications

7 Explanation and Additional Conditions

The proprietor was unable to recruit an early childhood qualified staff for this program. A primary school education degree qualified Teacher is acting in the qualified position. O'Connor Co-operative School Long Day Care caters for children aged from three to eight years of age.
