Blue Gum Outside School Hours (BGOSH) operated by Best - Practice Education Group Ltd is exempt from complying with *Children and Young People (ACT Childcare Services) Standards 2009 (No 1)* –

Standard 3.3) Positions requiring a qualified person must be filled with an adult holding one of the following qualifications:

Note: These qualifications are in addition to those specified in Core Standard 1.47.

- *a degree or diploma in education;*
- a Diploma of Children's Services (Out of School Hours Care) or equivalent;
- a Diploma of Youth Work;
- a person who has completed the third year of a Bachelor of Education and who is eligible for an internship with the ACT Department of Education;
- a Diploma of Leisure and Health;
- a Graduate Certificate in Childcare Management;
- an Advanced Diploma of Children's Services; or
- recognised overseas equivalent of any of the above qualifications.

7 Explanation and Additional Conditions

Blue Gum Outside School Hours is exempt from complying with Standard 3.3 while continuing to recruit to the position. A suitably qualified person is on site and will oversee the program.
