6 Temporary Standard Exemption Standard

Kids Fun Club Wanniassa operated by Celine D'Elboux is exempt from complying with *Children and Young People (ACT Childcare Services)* Standards 2009 (No 1) –

3.5) Persons working in the second and subsequent qualified positions at the service must be filled with an adult holding one of the following criteria;

a) any qualification detailed in Core Standard 1.47 or School Age Care Specific Standard 3.3;

b) studying towards a diploma or degree in a relevant field and has two years experience working in school age care;

- c) holds a Certificate IV in one of the following courses;
- i. Children Services
- *ii. Out of school hours care*
- iii. Lifestyle and leisure; or
- *d)* recognised overseas equivalent of the above qualifications.

The service will operate the program without a second qualified staff member whilst the qualification is completed.
