

Trespass on Territory Land (Minister's) Delegation 2010 (No 1)*

Notifiable Instrument NI2010 - 545

Made for the purposes of the

Trespass on Territory Land Act 1932 – see Legislation Act 2001, section 254A (Delegation by Minister)

1. Name of instrument

This instrument is the Trespass on Territory Land (Minister's) Delegation 2010 (No 1).

2. Commencement

This instrument commences on the day it is signed.

3. Delegation of functions

- (1) This section applies to each function under the Act listed in column 1 of the schedule.
- (2) The function is delegated to each of the delegates.
- (3) The *delegates* are the people who occupy the positions described in column 3 of the schedule.
