Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Canberra Institute of Technology Student Pre-paid Ticket Parking Scheme 2010 (No 1)

Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Regulation 2000, section 76 (Ticket parking schemes-road transport authority)

1. Establishment of scheme

I establish a ticket parking scheme for eligible students of the Canberra Institute of Technology ('CIT') comprising the following car parks:

- Tuggeranong carpark 1 Block 1 Section 18, Greenway;
- City carpark 10 Block 11 Section 33, Reid;
- City carpark 17 Block 6 Section 3, Parkes.

2. Purpose

The purpose of the ticket parking scheme is to allow certain students with limited means to purchase a parking ticket for a semester at a concessional price so that they are not disadvantaged by the location at which their course of study is offered.

3. Eligibility

For this instrument, a student is *eligible* if—

- (a) the student is enrolled at the CIT as a full-time student and is undertaking a course of study or training at the Reid Campus or Tuggeranong Flexible Learning Centre of the CIT; and
- (b) the student produces to an authorised staff member of the CIT the following documents as evidence that the student complies with paragraph (a):
 - (i) the student's ID card which is current for the whole semester that the student is applying for a parking ticket;
 - (ii) the student's subject schedule for the semester;

- (iii) evidence that the student has received an invoice for, or paid, the tuition fees for the semester; and
- (c) the student produces to an authorised staff member of the CIT one or more of the following documents:
 - (i) Centrelink Pension Concession Card;
 - (ii) Centrelink Health Care Card;
 - (iii) AUSTUDY or ABSTUDY allowance statement; and
- (d) the student produces to an authorised staff member of the CIT a current driver licence that has been issued to the student.

4. Authorised CIT staff member

For clause 3, a staff member of the CIT is *authorised* if he or she is authorised (however described) by the CIT to issue parking tickets for use by eligible students for the ticket parking scheme.

5. Repeal

I repeal the *Road Transport* (Safety and Traffic Management) CIT Ticket Parking Scheme 2005 (No 1) instrument dated 28 January 2005.
