(1) Name of Instrument

This instrument is the *Road Transport* (*Driver Licensing*) (*Public Vehicle Driver Training Course*) Approval 2011 (No 1).

(2) Commencement

This instrument commences on 1 July 2011.

(3) Authorisation

Under Regulation 65, I approve:

- (a) the course referred to in Schedule 1, if provided by the person listed in the schedule, as a suitable course:
 - i. for the training of people who wish to hold a public vehicle licence that authorises the person to drive a taxi, and
 - ii. for the purposes of section 94A(3) of the *Road Transport (Driver Licensing) Regulation 2000*; and
- (b) the person listed as course provider in Schedule 1 as the course provider.

(4) Revocation

This instrument revokes NI 2006 – 63 dated 10 March 2006 and NI 2007 -126 dated 24 April 2007.

- 1. An 85% pass rate and the full five (5) days attendance.
- 2. A satisfactory practical WAT assessment.
- 3. Being awarded a certificate of competency upon successful completion of the Theory Test and Practical Assessment as a means of obtaining a TAXI ('T') code added to any licence class other than a motor cycle class.

- 4. The competencies that must be achieved from the Transport and Logistics Training Package TLI10 are: TLIC2009A – Drive taxicab
 TLIB2090A – Use communication systems in a taxicab
 TLIF2072A – Comply with safety and security procedures
 TLIH3004A – Identify major roads, services and attractions
 TLII2019A – Provide taxicab customer service
 TLIL2060A – Complete induction to the transport industry
 TLIP2037A – Carry out financial transactions and maintain records
- 5. A driver of a Wheelchair Accessible Taxi must also achieve the competency: TLIC2040A – Provide wheelchair accessible taxi services to passengers with disabilities.

Practical assessment must occur using a wheelchair accessible taxi or a standalone taxi (ie simulator) in a workplace suitable for this purpose.

6. The course must be provided by approved trainers - Transport Industries Skills Centre.
