1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Children and Young People (Childcare Service Licence) Temporary Standards Exemption 2011 (No 4).*

2 Purpose of this Instrument

This instrument is to issue a *Temporary Standards Exemption* as specified in Section 749 (2) of the *Children and Young People Act 2008*.

3 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after notification.

This instrument expires six (6) months after the day it commences.

6 Temporary Standard Exemption Standard

C&K Southern Cross Early Childhood School operated by The Creche and Kindergarten Association of Queensland is exempt from complying with *Children and Young People (ACT Childcare Services) Standards 2009 (No 1)*

1.44) The maximum group sizes of children are:

Centre Based Care:

- a) 15 children for children aged birth to two years;
- b) 20 children for children aged between two to three years;
- c) 33 children for children aged three to five years; and
- d) For mixed age groups or family grouping, the maximum group size for the youngest child must be adhered to unless otherwise approved in writing by the licensing authority.

7 Explanation and Additional Conditions

The Service will exceed their maximum group size in the toddlers room. The Service will have two separate toddlers groups in the one room to allow for the increase in children enrolled at the Service. Child:staff ratios will be maintained at all times.
