1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the Emergencies (Service Provider) Approval 2011 (No 3).

2 Approval

(the approved provider) to provide ambulance services (the services) in the ACT at events approved in writing by the Emergency Services Commissioner (the Commissioner) for the period commencing on 01 September 2011 and ending on 31 August 2012.

SCHEDULE 1

CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL

1. This approval may be amended or revoked at anytime.
2. The approved provider may only perform the services within the geographical boundaries for the event specified by the approval referred to in Clause 2 of this instrument.
3. The approved provider must not provide emergency medical treatment at an event in the ACT unless the Commissioner has agreed in writing.
4. The approved provider must not transport any person outside the geographical boundaries of an approved event.
5. Staff of the approved provider who are not notified to the Commissioner in the original application may only provide services after the date of the instrument once approved in writing by the Commissioner.
6. The approved provider must provide copies of any updated or renewed insurance documentation if insurance is renewed during the approval period.
7. The approved provider must give the Commissioner copies of any clinical or pharmaceutical management guidelines implemented during the approval period.
