1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Children and Young People (Childcare Service Licence) Temporary Standards Exemption 2011 (No 31)*.

2 Purpose of this Instrument

This instrument is to issue a *Temporary Standards Exemption* as specified in Section 749 (2) of the *Children and Young People Act 2008*.

3 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after notification.

4 Expiry

This instrument expires six (6) months after the day it commences.

6 Temporary Standard Exemption Standard

Gilmore Kids Club operated by Communities @ Work is exempt from complying with *Children and Young People (ACT Childcare Services) Standards 2009 (No 1)* –

3.4) The position of the service or camp director / coordinator must be filled by an adult who has attained the age of 21 years, and who holds one of the qualifications listed in School Age Care Specific Standard 3.3.

7 Explanation and Additional Conditions

This exemption is required to allow the service to operate with a coordinator who is currently under 21 years of age. At least one other staff member working at the program must have attained the age of 21 years.
