

# Road Transport (Driver Licensing) Fire Brigade Members Exemption 2011 (No 1)\*

Notifiable Instrument NI2011 – 565

made under the

**Road Transport (Driver Licensing) Regulation 2000, section 93 (Exemption by authority from requirement to hold licence)**

## 1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the Road Transport (Driver Licensing) Fire Brigade Members Exemption 2011 (No 1).

## 2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day it is signed.

## 3 Exemption

I exempt a person who is a member of the ACT fire brigade from the requirement to hold a heavy vehicle driver licence (medium and heavy rigid classes only) if all the circumstances listed in clause 4 apply to the person.

## 4 Circumstances in which exemption applies

- a) the member holds a full driver licence that is not a motorcycle licence or a restricted licence;
- b) the member satisfies the eligibility requirements for a heavy vehicle driver licence (medium rigid class or higher), other than the requirement in section 28 (2) (h) of *the Road Transport (Driver Licensing) Regulation 2000*;
- c) the member is accompanied by an instructor who is the holder of a full licence of the medium rigid class or higher and has held the licence for at least 1 year; and
- d) the member is undergoing driver instruction in a vehicle of the medium or heavy rigid class used by the fire brigade; and
- e) the member in training does not undertake urgent duty driving.

## 5 Definition

In this instrument:

a *member of the ACT fire brigade* means a person listed in section 45 of the *Emergencies Act 2004* as constituting the fire brigade.
