1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Children and Young People (Childcare Service Licence) Temporary Standards Exemption 2011 (No 50)*.

2 Purpose of this Instrument

6 Temporary Standard Exemption Standard

Honey Tree Early Childhood Centre operated by Hewssa Pty Ltd as Trustee for the Papa Family Trust is exempt from complying with *Children and Young People (ACT Childcare Services) Standards 2009 (No 1)* –

Standard 1.47) Staff Qualifications

Positions requiring a qualified person must be filled by an adult who holds one of the following qualifications:

- a) Diploma in Community Services (Children's Services) or equivalent;*
- b) a Bachelor of Early Childhood Education;*
- c) an equivalent 3 year full time tertiary qualification specialising in early childhood from a university;*
- d) a recognised overseas equivalent of any of the above qualifications*

7 Explanation and Additional Conditions

The proprietor has recruited an unqualified staff member, who is currently completing the required qualifications and acts in a Room Leader position. The required educator to child ratio is being maintained at all times.
