1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Litter (Trolley Containment Systems) Approval 2012 (No 1)*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on 1 October 2012.

3 Approval of trolley containment systems – Act, s 24G (4)

- (1) I approve the following as trolley containment systems:
 - (a) a system that requires the deposit of money by customers to use a shopping trolley, which is refundable on the return of the trolley to a designated bay;
 - (b) a system by which a customer is required to purchase a token to use a shopping trolley, and the token is returned to the customer on the return of the trolley to a designated bay;
 - (c) cattle grids installed at the entrances and exits to shopping centre car parks, which impede or prevent the removal of trolleys from a shopping centre precinct; or
 - (d) a radio signal transmitter installed on a trolley, which transmits the trolley's location to its owner; but not so as to approve a system of wheel locks on trolleys, which are activated by radio signal or magnetic strip.
- (2) An approved trolley containment system must be maintained in good working order.

4 Revocation of former instrument

This instrument revokes the *Litter (Trolley Containment Systems) Approval* 2011 (No 1).
