1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the Emergencies (Service Provider) Approval 2013 (No 3).

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on 27 February 2013

3 Approval

SCHEDULE 1

Conditions on Motorsport Safety & Rescue Pty Ltd approval under section 62(4) of the *Emergencies Act 2004*

1. The approved provider may only perform the services within the ACT for the event specified by the approval referred to in Clause 3 of the instrument.
2. This instrument approves only the staff nominated by Motorsport Safety & Rescue Pty Ltd in its application for approval under Section 62 of the *Emergencies Act 2004*.
3. Staff not nominated by Motorsport Safety & Rescue Pty Ltd in its application for approval under Section 62 of the *Emergencies Act 2004* must be approved in writing by the Emergency Services Commissioner.
4. Motorsport Safety & Rescue Pty Ltd must provide the Emergency Services Commissioner with copies of any updated or renewed insurance documentation if insurance is renewed or varied during the approval period.
5. Motorsport Safety & Rescue Pty Ltd may respond to fires including:
 - Rubbish fires;
 - Vehicle fires; and
 - Assist drivers and passengers from vehicles.
6. Motorsport Safety & Rescue Pty Ltd may provide vehicle rescue services within the closed special stages.
7. Motorsport Safety & Rescue Pty Ltd may clean up minor oil or fuel spills.
