STATEMENT OF REASONS

DECISION NOT TO PROVISIONALLY REGISTER PARLIAMENT HOUSE (Block 2 Section 1, Capital Hill) IN THE ACT HERITAGE REGISTER

Assessment

The Council has decided not to enter Parliament House, Capital Hill, in the ACT Heritage Register because:

- 1. The place is located on National Land, and as such the *Heritage Act 2004* does not have direct effect;
- 2. Furthermore, the place is currently nominated to the Commonwealth Heritage List (Place ID. 105737), and the National Heritage List (Place ID. 105740) and the details of any future listing would be included on the ACT Heritage Database, providing public access to information about the ACT's heritage.

Duplication of listing on the ACT Heritage Register therefore would provide no additional legal protection to the place, nor would it provide additional information to the public about the heritage of the ACT.

The Council has not formed an opinion about the heritage values of this place.

Council has therefore decided not to enter the place in the ACT Heritage Register.
