#### 1. INTRODUCTION

#### 1.1 Purpose

This technical amendment will make the following change to the Territory Plan:

Provision / code	Changes
Inner North Precinct Code	Corrections to the precinct code.

#### 1.2 Public consultation

Under section 88 of the *Planning and Development Act 2007* (the Act) this type of technical amendment is not subject to public consultation.

#### 1.3 Process

This technical amendment has been prepared in accordance with section 87 of the *Planning and Development Act 2007* (the Act). The planning and land authority must notify the public of the commencement of this technical amendment.

#### 1.4 ACT Planning Strategy

This technical amendment is not inconsistent with the ACT Planning Strategy.

#### 1.5 Compliance with the Act

This technical amendment is compliant with:

- Section 87(a) of the *Planning and Development Act 2007* in that:
  - i) would not adversely affect anyone's rights if approved; and
  - ii) has as its only object the correction of a formal error in the plan.

#### 2. EXPLANATION

#### 2.1 Inner North Precinct Code

The Inner North Precinct Code contains Criterion C13 that states that it '...applies only to a *site* where at least one *regulated tree* is proposed to be retained within the *primary building zone*.'

The reference to *regulated tree* is incorrect. The intention was that C13 should apply to a *protected tree*, which is inclusive of both a *regulated tree* and a *registered tree*, as defined in the *Tree Protection Act 2005*.
