1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Emergencies (Service Provider) Approval 2014 (No 1)*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after its notification day.

3 Approval

I approve **Motorsport Safety & Rescue Pty Ltd** to provide ambulance services in the ACT at events approved in writing by the Emergency Services Commissioner.

4 Conditions on approval

I impose the conditions mentioned in schedule 1 to the approval.

5 Expiry

This instrument expires on 31 December 2014.

SCHEDULE 1

Conditions imposed on MOTORSPORT SAFETY & RESCUE PTY LTD approval under section 62 (4) of the *Emergencies Act 2004*

1. The Emergency Services Commissioner's approval mentioned in section 3 of this instrument must specify the geographical boundaries of the event.
2. Motorsport Safety & Rescue Pty Ltd must not transport any person outside the geographical boundaries of the event.
3. This instrument approves only the staff nominated in Motorsport Safety & Rescue Pty Ltd's application for approval under section 61 of the *Emergencies Act 2004* to provide ambulance services at an event.
4. Staff not nominated in Motorsport Safety & Rescue Pty Ltd's application for approval must be approved in writing by the Emergency Services Commissioner.
5. Motorsport Safety & Rescue Pty Ltd must provide the Emergency Services Commissioner with renewed insurance documentation if insurance is renewed during the approval period.
6. Motorsport Safety & Rescue Pty Ltd must provide the Emergency Services Commissioner with clinical or pharmaceutical management guidelines made by Motorsport Safety & Rescue Pty Ltd during the approval period.
